# **2019 Annual Meeting Minutes**

Thursday, April 4, 2019; Harley Davidson Museum, Milwaukee

Call to Order: WACEP President Dr. Jeffrey Pothof called the meeting to order at 12:35 pm. Minutes from the 2018 Annual Meeting and the 2018 financials were approved. Dr. Pothof welcomed and thanked attendees for participating in the Symposium & Research Forum, thanked all sponsors and exhibitors for their support of the event and of WACEP, and thanked his fellow Board members for their service and leadership. He provided an update on membership numbers and dues revenue, both of which remain strong and consistent from the prior year, and also reported that WACEP's financial position remains strong.

Annual Report: Dr. Pothof provided a recap of issues important to emergency medicine and the work being done at the state level. He highlighted the ongoing work of the Emergency Psych Task Force, a collaboration between WACEP and the Wisconsin Psychiatric Association, as well as WACEP's Rural Outreach initiative, which was designed to better understand and address unique challenges in EM in more rural parts of Wisconsin. He stressed the importance of being active legislatively and encouraged emergency physicians to contribute to the PAC and also make their voices heard at the annual Doctor Day event in Madison. One of WACEP's priority legislative issues continues to be improving Medicaid reimbursement, and other important efforts being addressed by the organization include Out of Network Billing, marijuana legalization, increased resident involvement and promotion of Fellow status (FACEP).

WACEP Award Presentations: Dr. Pothof presided over the awards ceremony and presented the following awards: Marielle Brenner, MD from MCW, and John Holzhauer, MD from UW, received the annual Resident Advocacy Awards; Howard J. Croft, MD, FACEP received the Distinguished Service Award; and Lisa Maurer, MD, FACEP was presented with the Past-President award. All were thanked for their commitment to the profession and the organization.

Research Forum Awards: Dr. Pothof introduced Dr. Amy Zosel, co-chair of the Wisconsin Emergency Medicine Research Forum, who recognized this year's Research Forum award winners.

Adjournment: There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 1 pm.
